**ANGUS I**

**GOFFREDI (mac) ANGUS I**  
*Given alternate surname MacAlasandar*  
**1st ever recognizable 'MacAlister'** - Reg Aven 299; 640v, 5/11/1395

**ANGUS OG II**

\***Angusi Goffredi** married **Anna**, **grand-daughter of John I, Lord of Isles and Princess Margaret.**  
30/10/1395 : Reg Aven, 300, 26.  
Dispensation : payment of "one mark of silver to the abbey of Sagadel" (Saddell).  
(Anna was daughter of **Mary de Insulis** & Lachlan McLean, 1st Duart, who married 1367.)

**JOHN — ABBOTT IONA between 1405 - c.1421.**  
**Iohannes, son of Goffredi Angusii MacAlasandar** (Reg Aven 296– 52-52v; 3/10/1395)  
**John was Abbot to Donald II, Lord of Isles, who gifted gold arm for relic of Columba.**

**JOHN MACALISTER**  
PARSON, GIGHA (d. c.1510)

Daughter + Sir Colin 'Iongatach' Campbell of Lochow. He is G/Ggrandfather of Colin 1st Earl of Argyll

**ABBOTT SADDLELL, KINTYRE**  
**1433 - 1456**

**"JOHN ANGUSII"**  
**"Clerk" (cleric) 1438,**  
"Mandate to **Saddell** abbot § to assign the rectory of St Congans, Ardnamurchan" to John (ie, his brother) . C.P.R., viii, 10  
\*CHRON'GY SADDLELL ABBEY' p117 A. MCKERRAL, 1951-52. S.A.S.

**"Iohannes Iohannis Macalistaire"**  
"Here lies Sir John, son of John MacAlister, parson of [Gigha? Kildalton?]  
Muireach MacKay, vicar of same, caused me to be made". Slab design c.1500-1550 (Inscription as rendered by RCAHMS )



**SIR JOHN MACALISTER.** Graveslab, Texa Island off Islay. Died c.1525.

Their natural son **Dugall Campbell** became the **Dean of Argyll.**  
**Alive 1442.** 'Connection' to Saddell Abbey then as Dean of Argyll and to his cousins: Abbots, Cleric.

**"BLACK JOHN"**  
as per "Clan Donald VOL III"; p.185. PEDIGREE "**VI**" 'MacAlister of Loup.'

**CHARLES ("VII") 1481. Steward, Kintyre**

**'MacALISTERS'**

1476 : Loup annexed from John II de Ila. 1481 - **No 'Loup' in the grant to "MacAlisters"**. 1493 - Lordship of Isles falls; all lands forfeited. Clan Campbell control. 1487-1532 : Eoin Caimbeul (I and II), Bishops of Isles, **Commendators of Iona Abbey.** **Saddell Abbey property goes to the See of Argyll;** it closes down 1500-1508. 1516: M'Allister Chief, **Angus m'John Dubh, "VIII"**. **Familiar & Servitor of Coline {Campbell} Earl of Argyll** (Privy Seal). **After 1516 to ? = 1st MacALISTERS + LOUP**

**IONA ABBEY**

GLENBARR ("ABBEY") - lands possibly endowed to Saddell?
