Abbey founder & Pilgrim to Rome and Jerusalem.

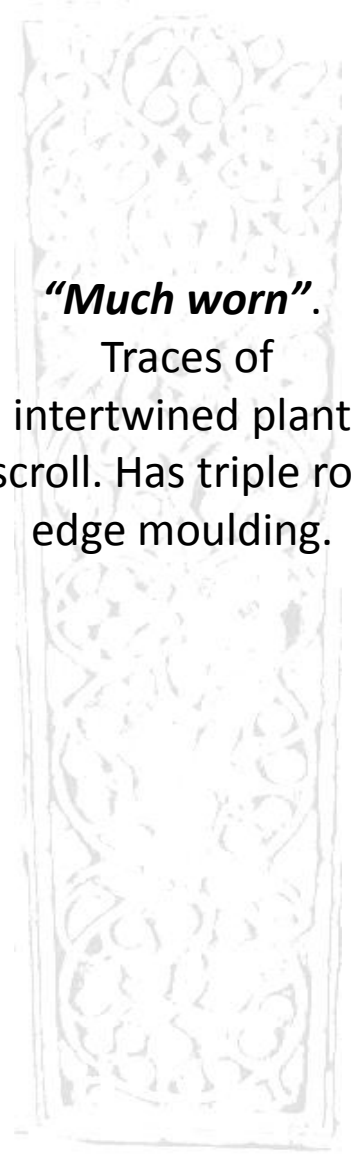

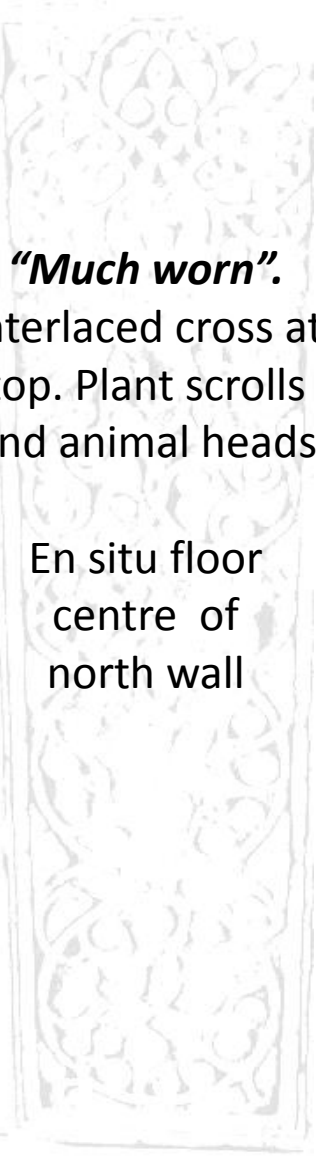
