

"THE MACDONNELL" *Emann Og Macdonnell, Nobilis*, High Constable and Chief of the Tyrone & Armagh MacDomhnaills (returned from Spain) who was Dean of Armagh, d.1601 (postulated for Archbishop of Armagh).

The two handed axe held high indicates the presence of the Clan MacDomnail Galloglaigh "*Ard constapla coicidh Uladh*", ie, the High Constable of Ulster.



The chair of 4 stones, the "*Leac Na Ri*", the King's Stone, of numerous 16th century descriptions was said to have been blessed by St Patrick – inset. It is the counterpart to the *Stone of Destiny*. It was destroyed by Lord Mountjoy and Chichester in 1602 by axe... "*brake downe the chair wherein the Oneales were wont to be created*".
